4. Beginning January 1, 2026, a person licensed under this chapter who recycles batteries from electric motor vehicles and or <del>plug-in</del> hybrid electric motor vehicles as defined in code 321.116, shall successfully complete a high voltage vehicle battery safe handling and storage education program that is approved by the department.

The national ARA sponsored Hill Day will take place in Washington DC on April 2-3, 2025. Pat Rooff moved to send a \$1000 PAC check to ARA, Jeremy Bevard second the motion. There was discussion as to what we sent in the past and when the check will be sent. It will be hand carried by Mike Swift and presented at Hill Day in DC. Dave Hesmer moved that \$1000 each for expenses will be covered for both Sue and Mike to attend ARA Hill Day for travel expense for airfare and hotel costs.

The preparation is complete and now all Board members and direct members need to get registered and get hotel reservation made. <u>https://ari-ne.org/convention/</u> There will be a Board and Member meeting at 10 :00 Friday, March 21, 2025. Mitzi will provide feedback on whether a recognition of Tim and Sherri from Smith Auto Parts & Sales takes place at GMARE or at a later date with a luncheon following their retirement.

#### Legislative Discussion

**EV education bill passed out of subcommittee** – need to send email to full Transportation Committee members – see next page for language and list of email addresses.

A bill (SF 292) that requires a lien check to be conducted was proposed to be added to the language of the law that allows for the purchase of vehicles 12 years or older to be acquired for \$1000 or less without a title. IAR is not opposed to the amendment as we had requested in the original bill. **IAR would like to open discussion on how the lien check will be able to be conducted on vehicles titled from out-of-state.** 

Senate File 230 a Towing Law Change sparked a lively discussion about the details of the bill. The three main issues were 1) shortening the notification period to 5 days. Auto recyclers are not opposed to that change as most do notification immediately upon possession; 2) requirement to allow the vehicle owner to collect their belongings from an impounded vehicle was not opposed as most people do allow folks to gather critical items such as car seats, purses, bags. Etc. however, concerns were raised about giving too much access due to liability of having public persons in the restricted areas; 3) the increase from 10 to 20 days for holding a vehicle was viewed as unnecessarily driving up

storage costs for insurance companies and lien holders. Most agreed that when request by insurance and/or lien holders a towed vehicle is given extra time just for asking and that the owner on title would not benefit with additional time as much as the majority would be penalized with additional storage fees on a regular basis.

Everyone agreed that we need more information as to whether the proposed changes were meant to also change abandoned vehicle rules or just the towing regulations. We will ask our Lobbyist for some clarification. The Board is inclined to register against the bill until the language is cleaned up.

# EPA's New Hazardous Waste e-Manifest Registration Requirements

According to the EPA, the new hazardous waste e-Manifest registration requirement mandates that all Small Quantity Generators (SQGs) and Large Quantity Generators (LQGs) must register within the e-Manifest system, meaning they need to create accounts to access and manage their hazardous waste manifests electronically; this includes the ability to submit reports and correct data as needed; the deadline for registration is January 22, 2025.

Recently, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) published the final rule which impacts hazardous waste generators and modifies certain aspects of the hazardous waste manifest.

Starting January 22, 2025, all Large and Small Quantity Generators of hazardous waste will be required to register and maintain an account in <u>RCRAinfo</u> to meet EPA's new electronic manifest (e-Manifest) system requirements. See <u>https://rcrainfo.epa.gov/</u> <u>rcrainfoprod/action/secured/login</u> for login information.

In the e-Manifest system facilities will be able to:

- Designate at least one staff person with certifier or site manager access in order to access manifests, submit reports (i.e., discrepancy or exception reports) and make data corrections (i.e., manifest errors) as needed.
- Obtain the required documentation to document the destruction of their hazardous waste.

Please note: With the transition from a five to a fourpage manifest, after January 22, generators will no longer receive paper manifests from disposal facilities documenting the destruction of their facility's hazardous waste.

While not required, EPA is also encouraging businesses classified as Very Small Quantity Generators of hazardous waste to register with the e-Manifest system to provide documentation on the proper management and destruction of their hazardous waste.

Auto recyclers generally do not generate hazardous waste unless they use solvent to clean parts or have gasoline that is unusable. Usually, the volume of hazardous waste generated by an auto recycler is less than 100 kg or 220 pounds per calendar month which places them in the Very Small Quantity Generator category and exempt from the new e-manifest requirement. *220 pounds is about 30 gallons of waste solvent, for reference.* Although it is not required, some hazardous waste management companies may begin using the new system exclusively and ask customers to register and use the system even if not required by law.

The EPA's new Hazardous Waste e-Manifest registration requirements apply to all states, meaning every generator, transporter, and receiving facility handling hazardous waste must register for e-

The Hazardous Waste e-Manifest System is a national electronic system designed to replace the traditional paper-based tracking method for hazardous waste shipments. The system allows for the electronic creation, transmission, and storage of hazardous waste manifests, streamlining the process and reducing errors. The EPA's goal with this system is to enhance the efficiency and accuracy of hazardous waste tracking, ultimately safeguarding public health and the environment.

# Very Small Quantity Generators (VSQGs) of hazardous waste have the following limits:

• **Monthly generation**: Less than 220 lbs (100 kg) of non-acute hazardous waste, and less than 2.2 lbs (1 kg) of acute hazardous waste

**On-site accumulation**: Less than 2,200 lbs (1,000 kg) of hazardous waste at any time VSQGs must also meet the following requirements:

- Identify all hazardous waste generated
- Deliver hazardous waste to an authorized person or facility

Comply with basic waste management requirements VSQGs are exempt from the full hazardous waste regulations that apply to larger generators.

### **Episodic events**

An episodic event is an activity that increases hazardous waste generation beyond the monthly limits for VSQGs. This includes planned events like maintenance and tank cleanouts, as well as unplanned events.

### **Reporting requirements**

VSQGs must notify the EPA of planned episodic events using EPA Form 8700-12 within 30 days. For unplanned events, the EPA must be notified within 72 hours

### Enforcement Alert to Auto Recyclers National Motor Vehicle Title Information System

### National Motor Vehicle Title Information System

or NMVTIS serves as a repository of information related to vehicles that have been in the possession of auto recyclers, junk yards and salvage yards. This repository is then used by states and consumers to ensure that junk or salvage vehicles are not later resold and ensures that the VINs from destroyed vehicles can never be used for a stolen automobile.

### **Reporting Methods**

Auto recyclers, junk yards, and salvage yards must submit the required monthly reports (every two business days in lowa) to NMVTIS through third party organizations that have agreed to provide this service. Reporting can be as frequently as desired, but not less frequently than monthly. The Department of Justice encourages all reporters to submit information to NMVTIS as soon as possible to prevent fraud and theft and to protect consumers. Contact a data consolidator for more information on reporting methods and technical specifications if you have not yet set up an account or if you need assistance getting caught up.

The U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs' Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) oversees the National Motor Vehicle Title Information System (NMVTIS), with the American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA) serving as the system operator.

Recently the BJA has issued a warning to entities that have not met the reporting requirement that enforcement will begin with those that have NEVER reported. Additionally, the fine has increased from \$1000 per VIN to \$1850 per non-compliance. The DOJ BJA stated:

"BJA is currently assessing entities that have registered to report to NMVTIS but have not reported any junk and salvage automobiles. All required reporting entities are encouraged to comply with the reporting requirements that are outlined on the NMVTIS Program page at <u>https:// vehiclehistory.bja.ojp.gov/nmvtis\_auto</u>. For entities that fail to come into compliance, BJA will, as appropriate, initiate civil actions that may lead to penalties." The pending threat of enforcement should not be taken lightly given that steep fines may be levied per vehicle and can be retroactive back to the March 2009 implementation date. Check your reporting status at <u>https://</u> <u>www.nmvtis-le.org/NMVTISReportingStatus</u>.

**Sue Schauls** recommends that you address the issue immediately and seek assistance through **Auto Data Direct** to begin or update reporting of VINs and set up an ongoing method to stay compliant as the second wave of enforcement could focus on those that are behind reporting at least monthly.

Check your NMVTIS reporting status at <u>https://</u> <u>www.nmvtis-le.org/NMVTISReportingStatus</u> to see the last report date. Many yards are discovering discrepancies between their records and NMVTIS data.
